

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

S.N.	Frequently Asked Question	Response
1.	I have registered my candidature, but not able to fill-up the application.	The link for submission of application and remittance of Examination fee will be activated from 21.09.2021 (10.00 hrs.) onwards and shall remain active till 06.10.2021 23.59 hrs.
2.	My qualification is not available in the qualification drop-down.	The candidate holding qualification as mentioned against the post and para 14 and 15 of the vacancy notice are eligible and can submit their application.
3.	Is AMIE recognised qualification for the posts?	<p>In terms of AICTE clarifications students who enrolled with Professional bodies/ institutions on or before 31st May 2013 for technical courses which were duly recognised by MHRD with permanent recognition on or before 31st May 2013, have been recognised by AICTE for equivalence.</p> <p>Accordingly, only those who have enrolled for AMIE or similar courses with professional bodies/ institutions, prior to 31.05.2013 and have subsequently passed the examination, can apply for the post. The para 13 of detailed Vacancy Notice may be referred.</p>
4.	Those appearing in the examination of the required qualification are eligible or not?	No. Candidate should have passed the examination and at the time of submission of the application.
5.	If result is awaited, can a candidate apply for a post?	No. As clarified above.
6.	Is any change / edit in the information is possible after submission of application	No. Candidates are advised to fill in all the information carefully while filling the application form. No alteration/ change in information once submitted is permissible.
7.	Will the job be regularised in NCRTC after completion of contract period?	No. The job is purely on contract basis.
8.	Is any other mode of payment acceptable?	No. Only Online mode of payment as mentioned in the advertisement is acceptable.
9.	Is the fees paid refundable?	The fees once paid is not refundable.
10.	What are the age relaxations permissible?	For age relaxations may please refer the detailed advertisement uploaded on career page of the NCRTC website.
11.	What will be the pattern of examination?	The examination will be Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ). There will be 100 questions to be answered in 90 minutes. 1/3rd marks will be deducted for each wrong

		answer. For further details may please refer career page of NCRTC website.
12.	Is there any lower age limit for applying?	The candidate should not be less than 18 years of age.
13.	Is it possible to change the mobile no. / email address	Alteration/ change in information once submitted is not permissible. Registered Mobile no. and email once submitted, shall be used for future communication.
14.	Can I apply for more than one post?	<p>While there is no bar for candidate to apply for more than one post, exam for all the posts is likely to be conducted on the same date and time.</p> <p>Therefore, it is advisable that candidate apply against One Post only.</p>
