Namo Bharat: A Year of Transformative Transit

Celebrating a significant milestone, Namo Bharat trains have successfully completed one year of operations, serving over 40 lakh commuters and revolutionizing regional connectivity.

The Hon'ble Union Minister of Housing & Urban Affairs and Power, Shri Manohar Lal, took a commemorative ride on the Delhi-Ghaziabad -Meerut RRTS corridor on October 21, 2024, engaging directly with passengers and women train operators.

He gathered firsthand feedback, expressing satisfaction with the overwhelmingly positive response.

Commuters enthusiastically praised the trains' convenience, speed, and comfort, highlighting how Namo Bharat has transformed their daily commute by providing a reliable and hassle-free alternative to traditional transportation modes.

From its first day of operations, passengers have benefited from the National Common Mobility Card (NCMC), enabling seamless travel across multiple modes of transport under the Government of India's "One Nation, One Card" initiative.

The RRTS showcases innovative technologies

under the 'Make in India' and 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' initiatives, offering connectivity to multiple transit options including metro lines, railway stations, and inter-state bus terminals.

Currently spanning 42 kilometers and covering nine strategic stations from Sahibabad to Meerut South. Namo Bharat has transformed commuting experiences. The corridor is set to expand to 55 kilometers, with upcoming sections connecting Sahibabad to New Ashok Nagar, including key stations like Anand Vihar.



By June 2025, the complete 82-kilometer RRTS corridor will enable passengers to travel from Delhi to Meerut in under an hour, representing a remarkable leap in regional connectivity and setting a new standard for urban transportation.


These new features add to the growing list of functionalities







एनसीआरटीसी और दिल्ली मेट्रो ने की एकीकृत क्यूआर-टिकटिंग प्रणाली लॉन्च



11 नवंबर, 2024: एनसीआरटीसी और दिल्ली मेट्रो रेल कॉर्पोरेशन (डीएमआरसी) ने एक एकीकृत क्यूआर-टिकटिंग प्रणाली की शुरुआत की है, जिससे यात्रियों के लिए दिल्ली-एनसीआर में यात्रा अधिक सहज और सुविधाजनक हो गई है। यह एकीकृत प्रणाली यात्रियों को क्यूआर कोड का उपयोग करके नमो भारत (आरआरटीएस) और दिल्ली मेट्रो दोनों सेवाओं के लिए टिकट बुक / खरीदने की सुविधा प्रदान करती है। यात्री 'आरआरटीएस कनेक्ट' ऐप और 'डीएमआरसी मोमेंटम 2.0' ऐप के माध्यम से दिल्ली मेट्रो या नमो भारत की टिकट जनरेट कर सकते हैं।

यह एकीकरण यात्रा प्रक्रिया को सरल बनाता है, जिससे यात्री एक साथ दोनों नेटवर्क के लिए टिकट बुक कर सकते हैं। इसके अतिरिक्त, एनसीआरटीसी ने इससे पहले आईआरसीटीसी के साथ भी ऐसे ही एक समझौते पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, जिसकी मदद से यात्रियों को आईआरसीटीसी प्लेटफॉर्म पर भारतीय रेलवे सेवाओं के साथ-साथ नमो भारत टिकट बुक करने की सुविधा भी मिल रही है। अब 42 किलोमीटर परिचालित आरआरटीएस कॉरिडोर के साथ डीएमआरसी के 393 किलोमीटर लंबे मेट्रो नेटवर्क से जुड़ने से, यात्रियों को बेहतर कनेक्टिविटी और अधिक कुशल यात्रा अनुभव का लाभ मिल रहा है।

सरकार की 'वन इंडिया-वन टिकट' पहल के अनुरूप, जिसका उद्देश्य यात्रियों के लिए इंटर-मॉडल यात्रा को यथासंभव सुविधाजनक बनाना है, यह पहल टिकटिंग प्रक्रिया को सरल बनाएगी।


नमो भारत अनप्लग्ड: लाइव म्यूज़िकल फ़्राईडेज़ के सीज़न 1 का यादगार समापन






नमो भारत का दिल्ली में हुआ आगमन


Rental Power Bank Facility for Mobile Charging



Meerut South RRTS Station The Gateway to Meerut

The Meerut South RRTS station, which opened for passenger operations on 18 August 2024, boasts the largest parking facility along the RRTS Corridor in Uttar Pradesh, significantly enhancing commuter convenience.



Key features of the Meerut South station include:

- Extensive Parking: The station has two parking lots covering approximately 13,000 square meters, located on either side of the entry/exit.
 - Capacity for around 1,200 vehicles, including both four-wheelers and two-wheelers.
 - Dedicated parking spaces for auto-rickshaws.
- Easy Pickup and Drop-off: Designed for smooth vehicle access from both Meerut and Delhi, with direct access from the main road for easy pickup and drop-off.
- Accessibility: The station includes designated parking for passengers with disabilities, along with ramps for easy access to ensure comfortable travel on the Namo Bharat train.

- Connectivity: Serving as the gateway to Meerut, the station facilitates travel for commuters from nearby areas such as Mohiuddinpur, Bhudbaral, Bahadurpur, Aminagar, Chhajjupur, Kharkhoda, and Kadarabad. The Namo Bharat train service from Meerut South enables passengers to reach Sahibabad in approximately 30 minutes.
- Multi-modal Transport: In addition to RRTS services, the station will also accommodate local metro services for the Meerut region, with three tracks—two for RRTS and one for metro—across three platforms.
- Station Design: The station spans three levels—ground, mezzanine, and concourse—covering a total length of 215 meters, width of 36 meters, and height of 22 meters.

This state-of-the-art station enhances the overall travel experience, making commuting to and from Meerut more efficient and convenient.



Has your experience here changed the way you view your career or future goals?


Absolutely. It has opened my eyes to new opportunities in rail transportation and inspired me to grow further in this field.


