Ushering in a New Era Namo Bharat Train Debuts in Delhi



Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi receives paintings and artworks from commuters during his journey on the Namo Bharat Train from Sahibabad to New Ashok Nagar Station.

The much-awaited Namo Bharat train has officially arrived in Delhi, marking a significant milestone in India's regional connectivity.

On January 5, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 13-km Delhi stretch of the Delhi-Ghaziabad- Meerut Namo Bharat corridor, extending the operational network to 55 km with 11 state-of-the-art stations.

The Prime Minister travelled aboard the Namo Bharat train from Sahibabad to New Ashok Nagar Namo Bharat station, interacting with commuters, including school children who presented him with sketches and poems.

The Delhi section introduces the corridor's first underground stretch, spanning six kilometres and featuring Anand Vihar, a flagship station offering seamless connectivity to Meerut South in just 35 minutes. New Ashok Nagar station, the first elevated stop in the Delhi stretch, will connect directly to the Delhi Metro's Blue Line via a 90-meter foot overbridge.

Passenger services commenced the same day, with trains running at every 15 minutes. Commuters can now travel from New Ashok Nagar to Meerut South Namo Bharat station in less than 40 minutes, cutting travel time to one-third.

In addition to enhancing connectivity, the Namo Bharat corridor supports environmental sustainability. Once fully operational, this corridor is estimated to reduce over one lakh private vehicles from roads annually and cut carbon emissions by 2.5 lakh tonnes per annum. The 82-km corridor willreshape transit for millions in the region.

मेरठ मेट्रो का ट्रायल रन शुरू: मेरठ साउथ से मेरठ सेंट्रल तक दौड़ी मेट्रो



मेरठ में स्थानीय मेट्रो के परिचालन की दिशा में एक महत्वपूर्ण कदम बढ़ाते हुए एनसीआरटीसी ने मेरठ मेट्रो का ट्रायल रन आरंभ कर दिया, जिसमें मेट्रो को मेरठ साउथ से मेरठ सेंट्रल के भूमिगत खंड तक अलग-अलग गति पर चलाकर परीक्षण किया गया। शुरुआत में ट्रेन को मैन्युअल तरीके से 40 से 135 किमी/घंटा की गति पर ऑपरेट कर इसकी तकनीकी जांच की गई।

परीक्षण में सुरक्षा, सिग्नलिंग, प्लेटफॉर्म स्क्रीन डोर (पीएसडी), और यात्रियों के आराम को परखा गया। मेरठ मेट्रो के 12 ट्रेनसेट में से 10 दुहाई डिपो पहुंच चुके हैं। ये वातानुकूलित ट्रेनें आधुनिक सुविधाओं जैसे यूएसबी चार्जिंग, सामान रखने की रैक और आरामदायक सीटिंग से लैस हैं।

मेरठ मेट्रो कॉरिडोर 23 कि.मी. लंबा है, जिसमें 13 स्टेशन बनाए जा रहे हैं। इनमें 3 भूमिगत और 10 एलिवेटेड स्टेशन शामिल हैं। शताब्दी नगर, बेगमपुल, और मोदीपुरम पर नमो भारत और मेरठ मेट्रो दोनों सेवाएं मिलेंगी।

एनसीआरटीसी का लक्ष्य है कि इस साल मेट्रो सेवा को पूरी तरह से परिचालित कर जनता को समर्पित किया जाए।

गाजियाबाद नमो भारत स्टेशन से मेट्रो स्टेशन तक यात्रियों के लिए निःशुल्क शटल सेवा



एनसीआरटीसी ने गाजियाबाद के नमो भारत स्टेशन और शहीद स्थल, न्यू बस अड्डा मेट्रो स्टेशन के बीच निःशुल्क शटल सेवा शुरू की है। यह पहल यात्रियों की सुविधा और लास्ट माइल कनेक्टिविटी को बेहतर बनाने के उद्देश्य से की गई है।

शटल सेवा के तहत ई-रिक्शा उपलब्ध हैं, जो इन दोनों परिवहन साधनों के बीच की लगभग 300 मीटर की दूरी को कवर करते हुए पीक आवर्स में यात्रियों को निःशुल्क और सुरक्षित यात्रा प्रदान करेंगे। इसके साथ ही, यह

पर्यावरण-अनुकूल परिवहन को भी बढ़ावा देता है।

यात्रियों की संख्या बढ़ने पर भविष्य में और ई-रिक्शा द्वारा इस सेवा का विस्तार किया जाएगा। दोनों स्टेशनों के बीच सीधा संपर्क न होने के कारण यात्री असुविधा का सामना कर रहे थे।

एनसीआरटीसी ने इस समस्या को हल करने के लिए शटल सेवा शुरू की है। मेट्रो स्टेशन और नमो भारत स्टेशन को फुट ओवर ब्रिज द्वारा जोड़ने की योजना है, जिसका निर्माण आरंभ हो गया है।



जब तक निर्माण कार्य पूरा नहीं हो जाता यह शटल सेवा यात्रियों के लिए उपलब्ध रहेगी। इसके अलावा, गाजियाबाद सिटी ट्रांसपोर्ट सर्विसेज लिमिटेड की इलेक्ट्रिक बसें और अन्य फीडर सेवाएं

यात्रियों को लास्ट माइल कनेक्टिविटी प्रदान कर रही हैं। एनसीआरटीसी का यह प्रयास यात्रियों के लिए यात्रा को आसान, सुरक्षित और सुविधाजनक बनाने की दिशा में एक बड़ा कदम है।

Smart Locker Facility Introduced at Sahibabad and Ghaziabad Namo Bharat Stations



Passengers travelling on the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Namo Bharat Corridor can now avail secure and affordable storage solutions, thanks to the introduction of

smart locker facilities. Initially launched at Sahibabad and Ghaziabad stations, this facility will soon be available across all Namo Bharat stations.

The smart lockers, available in small, medium, large, and extra-large sizes, cater to varied storage needs.

Passengers can book lockers for durations ranging from one to six hours at rates of Rs 20, Rs 30, and Rs 40 per hour, depending on the size. Payments can be conveniently made via UPI, ensuring a seamless experience. If luggage exceeds the booking duration, an additional hourly charge will apply.

To rent a locker, passengers must register their details on the locker's digital interface or through the

Namo Bharat and DMRC Momentum apps. The app's 'Rent a Locker' feature allows passengers to select the station, date, locker size, and usage duration. Upon payment, users receive a unique access code to secure and access their locker.


These lockers offer additional convenience by doubling as collection points for e-commerce parcels. Delivery personnel can place parcels in lockers after a security check, using

the customer's access code to ensure safety.

Currently, smart locker installation is underway at other operational stations as well, including DPS Raj Nagar Guldhar, Duhai, Muradnagar, Modi Nagar South, Modi Nagar North, and Meerut South. With plans to extend the service soon to Anand Vihar and New Ashok Nagar in Delhi, the locker facility will be made available at all Namo Bharat stations.

Loyalty Points Program for Namo Bharat Commuters Launched

NCRTC has introduced a loyalty points program for Namo Bharat commuters purchasing tickets through the 'Namo Bharat Connect' mobile app. Under the program, passengers earn one point for every rupee spent on tickets, with each point valued at Rs. 0.10. These points can be redeemed for future ticket

purchases. New users receive 500 loyalty points (worth Rs. 50) upon downloading the app, with an additional 500 points available through referrals.

This program aims to enhance commuter convenience and encourage digital ticketing adoption. Launched by Shri Shalabh

Goel, MD, NCRTC, at Sahibabad Namo Bharat station, this initiative offers a 10% discount on Namo Bharat tickets while promoting paperless travel through digital QR tickets. The launch event also marked the unveiling of the first edition of Namo Bharat Times, NCRTC's bi-monthly commuter newsletter.

Under the loyalty program, commuters will earn one point for every rupee spent on Namo Bharat train journeys using an NCMC card.

Each point is valued at Rs 0.10 (10 paise) and will be credited to the commuter's NCMC account. NCRTC's push for digital and paperless ticketing continues with this initiative, reaffirming its commitment to enhancing affordability, convenience, and sustainability in urban transit.

नमो भारत ट्रेन के सभी स्टेशनों पर मिलेगी एटीएम की सुविधा








Namo Bharat Commuter of the **Month**

A Transit Marvel Anand Vihar Namo Bharat Station



Inaugurated on January 5, 2025 by Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Anand Vihar Namo Bharat station stands out as the only operational underground station on the Namo Bharat corridor, located only one level below ground, ensuring seamless passenger movement.

Key features of the Anand Vihar Namo Bharat station include:

Multimodal Connectivity

Strategically located, Anand Vihar Namo Bharat station connects to:

- Delhi Metro (Blue and Pink Lines)
- **Anand Vihar Railway Station**
- Swami Vivekananda ISBT
- **UPSRTC Kaushambi Bus Terminal**

Unique Bridges for Accessibility

Three bridges over Ghazipur drain link the station to Chaudhary Charan Singh Marg:

- A 10m-wide bridge for vehicle entry
- A 13m-wide bridge for vehicle exit
- A 5m-wide bridge dedicated to pedestrians

State-of-the-Art Commuter Facilities

The station offers three high-capacity lifts connecting the platform and metro stations, five strategically placed escalators, and two spacious entry/exit gates for smooth access. The station is designed for seamless multi-modal connectivity, providing easy transfers between metro, railway stations and buses. Inside the station, passengers can avail a range of amenities, including real-time live parking status facility for their vehicles on Namo Bharat Connect app.

Rapid Connectivity

With the Namo Bharat train operating at 160 km/h, Anand Vihar enables travel from Delhi to Meerut South in just 35 minutes, redefining regional transit.

The station encourages public transport use, reducing road congestion and supporting eco-friendly commuting.
